Zac R. Henderson

Coach Zac R. Henderson had three passions in life: his teams, his community, and golf. A graduate of Quanah High School, Zac enlisted in the army to serve this country for three years in WWII in the 168th Anti-Aircraft Artillery, putting him in that elite class of The Greatest Generation.

Following the war, Henderson played football at Texas Tech then earned a teaching degree at TCU and Masters at LSU. In 1950 he began his coaching career and married his sweetheart for life, Auline. In 1962, Zac permanently moved his family to Burkburnett to become the head football coach and Athletic Director of the Bulldogs.

Coach Henderson's advice to his students to be winners was never limited to the playing field. Some of his favorite saying were, "Winners never quit. We may not always be first, but we are all champions. Remember when you leave the playing field, the friendships you make and the lessons you learn make you who you are."

As Blacksox General Manager Mickey Cornleius will attest, it was Coach Henderson's custom to make the rounds each morning having coffee at local businesses including Cornelius Insurance. Oftentimes in the course of conversation a community need came up, and a few days later, Zac would show up at the right office, checkbook in hand. Several of those checks went towards the birth of a college prep baseball team, which would become the Blacksox. Ever wonder how the Blacksox home field got its name? Around 1987, over coffee, Henderon learned that the Burkburnett High School baseball field needed lights to comply with a new UIL ruling. Coach Henderson stepped up to the plate to make it happen. He was a high school football coach with a generous heart, especially toward his teams and his community, but what Coach Zac Henderson loved above all was his family.

"We hope the Zac R. Henderson Memorial Tournament becomes a part of your family's baseball story, and in the spirit of our dad and his love of the game, we say to all of you, "Put me in, Coach, I'm ready to play!"



ISTORY OF AND INFORMATION ABOUT THE BURKBURNETT BLACKSOX TEAM

The Burkburnett Blacksox are among the nation's oldest and finest college preparatory programs for high school age players who aspire to play college or professional baseball. The Blacksox sponsor teams at several different age levels to assist their players in improving both as baseball players but more importantly as young men. With the Blacksox organization entering its 4th decade it has unrivaled experience and knowledge that it uses to help its players fulfill their baseball dreams and to develop into outstanding men. The Blacksox organization feels that it has the responsibility to help its players become more productive members of society.

The team began in 1976 with a meager budget of \$800. Because of its initial very small financial base the team had to use volunteer umpires who were willing to officiate their games for free. Field problems also plagued the team, as it was the lowest in priority of six teams seeking to use the same diamond.

This Burkburnett organization struggled for two years until the local American Legion Post began sponsoring it in 1978. The annual budget then increased to \$3,500; the name "Blacksox" was adopted. Under Legion sponsorship the Sox experienced the excitement of playing international baseball in an 8-game journey through England that led to becoming a "brother club" to the Clifton Cougars of Nottingham -a relationship that continues today.

Mickey Cornelius, owner of the Cornelius Insurance Agency in Burkburnett, assumed the responsibilities of General Manager in 1984. At that time the team's budget climbed to \$12,000; local Burkburnett businesses helped make possible \$350,000 in improvements to the high school baseball field; and the Sox finally had a place to call home.

The Blacksox developed into the dominant team of its age bracket in Texoma with a reputation that has attracted players from the local area, all of Texas, several states, and even as far away as Australia. The Blacksox programs compete in AABC. In 2013 the Blacksox sent teams to 4 different championship events in AABC Baseball in four age categories. The Sox have been perennial qualifiers for the Texas AABC state tournament, advancing to regional play 10 times and competing in the 1992 Connie Mack World Series, 2009 World Series, winning the 2010 Series in 17 year old and finishing 3rd in 2011.

In addition, the organization annually hosts some six tournaments consisting of varsity and junior varsity levels in the high school season, 16 & under and 18 & under divisions during the summer season, and often a state or regional tournament in either or both of those divisions. Their home tournaments routinely attract teams from throughout Texas as well as Oklahoma, Colorado, and other states and result in an annual financial gain for the Wichita Falls economy of \$300,000-400,000 in overnight lodging, meals, recreation, etc.

The Burkburnett Blacksox Baseball Team has greatly progressed over the past 40 years from a recreational team to a nationally recognized and respected college preparatory team with an annual budget of more than \$350,000 and a fully-furnished dormitory to house the players and assistant coaches from the collegiate ranks. More than 900 alumni have advanced to collegiate baseball, many of whom are now lawyers, bankers, businessmen, civic leaders, and parents of future successes; scholarships totaling some \$3.7 million have been awarded to past players; at least 67 have been drafted by major league organizations; and about three dozen have played or are currently playing professional baseball.

The Blacksox opened their new 7,000 sq. ft. workout building in June 2000. This state-of-the-art facility was donated by the Gomez family of Colleyville, Texas and bears their name, The Gomez Workout Facility. It contains indoor cages for hitting, mounds for pitching, and cameras that are connected to video recorders and monitors. There is a full weight room, a full kitchen and lounge area with pool table, big screen television, and DVD players. The Gomez Facility is recognized as one of the finest facilities of its type.

In 2003, the Blacksox began operations of the Blacksox Baseball Academy . The Academy is designed to give players the benefit of instruction and a high level of competition throughout the summer. The Academy is housed in the Cornelius Center, which opened in 2003. The Cornelius Center is a 9000 square foot facility with housing for 80 players and their coaches. There is also a practice infield and 7 practice pitching mounds located next to the facility. The facility is unlike any other in amateur baseball.

The tradition that began in 1976 continues today. The Blacksox are especially proud of the 2010 17 year old team that won the World Series Championship in New Mexico in July of 2010. 2011 saw the Sox grow to 5 teams of 16, 17, & 18 year old players and had the largest college signed class ever. In 2013 the Sox took on more growth with 7 teams and a first ever age 15 team. 2018 looks to be better than ever. The move to include a youth program gave the Blacksox 7 more age groups and expanded the program by over 100 more players giving the Blacksox almost 200 players a year that get to showcase their talent. The goal of the Burkburnett Blacksox is to create great kids on and off of the field, and we look forward to this every year because of the good players and families that make up this organization.

2018 added professional player Griffin Russell as a part of the staff. This will strengthen our pitching game and bring great strength to the entire program.






The Gomez **Workout Facility**

For the 2001 season, the Blacksox opened a new addition to the program. The Gomez Workout Facility opened its doors, neighboring the Blacksox Dorm. This 7,000 square foot, state-of-the-art workout facility provides the Blacksox players with amenities greater than most college and professional teams in America.

The facility was graciously donated to the Blacksox by the parents of a former player, Mr. and Mrs. Raul and Jymme Gomez. Their gift to the Blacksox is one that benefits not only the team's players, but also youth from any age.

The Gomez facility houses two batting tunnels with pitching machines, a pitching tunnel, a weight room, player dorm, coaches bedroom, kitchen, game room, showers, and a large living area so players can analyze their workout sessions.



In addition to its use by the Blacksox, the facility provides housing for visiting teams during high school and summer sessions. Also, the Gomez Facility can be used by groups and teams who wish to have workout sessions in the facility. The Gomez has even been used to host wedding parties, and was the site of a corporation's Christmas party.

A few years ago, the Blacksox organization obtained a 1,800 square-foot building in Burkburnett when it became available for purchase from the local Sertoma Club. It was remodeled to include a full kitchen, walk-in showers and sleeping quarters for 20 players and a coach. The Blacksox were proud to dedicate the facility to the memory of **Monte Schenk**, who played for the Blacksox and Titans for three seasons and was tragically taken from us in an auto accident.


CHRIS HAYERS
